

## Supply List – Easy Peasy Set-In Circles

- Machine-in good working order.
- Manual for machine.
- Open-toed piecing foot.
- Straight stitch throat plate if you already have one.
- Eight 9 ½” squares of quality 100% cotton quilting fabric. Four squares will be the inset circles, the other 4 will be the square surround. Tightly woven fabrics work best.
- Short, sharp scissors.
- Blue wash out marker.
- Elmer’s washable School Glue stick, “disappearing purple”.
- 1’ rolling brayer.
- Quality piecing thread, preferred 50 or 60 weight.
- Wound bobbin (same thread choices as above).
- Topstitch needle, 80/12.
- Scissors or snips.
- Pencil and paper to take notes.
