

Supply List – Julianne Pillow

- Three pieces of quality, solid color 100% cotton fabric; two 14" x 22", one 17" x 22".
- One piece of thin batting (poly or cotton) 14" x 22".
- Fabric for design:
 - You are looking for fabrics with motifs that are 2 – 3 ½" wide that you will fussy cut and assemble into your design.
 - Kaffe Fasset fabrics are a rich source but there are many others.
 - Look for something that you think is fun!
 - Bring several selections from your stash. This may be an excuse to get more fabric 😊
- Two strips of fusible interfacing, 1 ½" x 22".
- Thread:
 - Cotton 60 wt quality cotton in a similar color of your fabric.
 - 2 metallic threads (of course you can add more if you'd like!). *Must be* high quality metallic thread. Threads that are all metallic with no poly core work best. You can't go wrong with Superior Glitter or Metallic, or, Yenmet Metallic.
 - Monopoly thread.
- Needles: 60/8 universal or sharp/microtex; 80/12 topstitch and 90/12 topstitch.
- Sequins: ¼ – 3/8" size, 2 or 3 colors. You may want to add some larger 3/4 – 1" shapes like butterflies, flowers, etc.
- Seed Beads: 3 – 4 colors/sizes. On the class sample I used seed beads from 07 to 11.
- Presser feet and stitch plates:
 - straight stitch plate if you have one, fine if you don't.
 - Zigzag plate.
 - Your best foot for piecing.
 - Open-toe embroidery foot.
 - Zipper foot.
- 18" or longer zipper of a similar color to fabric.

We will not assemble the pillow in class, but to complete the pillow you would need a 20" x 12" pillow form.
