Supply List – Julianne Pillow

- Three pieces of quality, solid color 100% cotton fabric; two 14" x 22", one 17" x 22".
- One piece of thin batting (poly or cotton) 14" x 22".
- Basic sewing supplies: fabric scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.
- Fabric for design:
 - o You are looking for fabrics with motifs that are 2-3% wide that you will fussy cut and assemble into your design.
 - o Kaffe Fasset fabrics are a rich source but there are many others.
 - o Look for something that you think is fun!
 - o Bring several selections from your stash. This may be an excuse to get more fabric $\stackrel{\smile}{\smile}$
- Two strips of fusible interfacing, 1 ½" x 22".
- Thread:
 - o Quality cotton or poly thread in the various colors of your fabric. Black comes in handy plus maybe 3 -4 other colors from your fabrics.
 - o Optional: Metallic threads. *Must be* high quality metallic thread.
- Needles: 80/12 topstitch and 90/12 topstitch.
- Presser feet and stitch plates:
 - o straight stitch plate if you have one, fine if you don't.
 - o Zigzag plate.
 - o Your best foot for piecing.
 - o Open-toe embroidery foot.
 - o Zipper foot (we may not get to the zipper in class).
- 18" or longer zipper of a similar color to fabric.

OPTIONAL:

- o Sequins, various sizes; you may want some shaped like butterflies, flowers, etc.
- o Seed Beads: 3 4 colors/sizes. On the class sample I used seed beads from 07 to 11.
- o Hand sewing needles for the beads and sequins.
- o If you want to try sewing on beads by machine:
 - Size 60 microtex needle.
 - Clear thread.
 - Tweezers.

We will not assemble the pillow in class, but to complete the pillow you would need a 20" x 12" pillow form.
